



Washington won't support Britain or France in war


- **2 term precedent:** Washington doesn't run for a 3rd term
- **Farewell Address:** warned a/b political parties + foreign alliances

Favored a national <u>bank</u>		Opposed a national bank	
Economy based on manufacturing and shipping		Economy based on <u>Farming</u>	
Supporters: lawyers, merchants, manufacturers, clergy		Supporters: farmers, tradespeople
